Guidelines & Rules of Conduct

What your child should bring:

All necessary camp materials and supplies, including a morning snack, will be provided for each child. Please make sure your child dresses comfortably each day and is prepared for the weather. Outdoor activities will be held rain or shine. Please bring a labeled bag or backpack with sunscreen and bug spray. We recommend having applying sunscreen before arriving to camp. For **children enrolled in the full day program**, a bagged lunch including drinks is also needed.

Children's Belongings:

Please label all belongings. Dumbarton House or Tudor Place is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Personal belongings should be kept in a backpack.

Drop-Off & Pick-Up:

Parents should drop off and pick up their children on time each day. A photo ID will be required to pick up campers each day of camp.

Late Pick-Up Fees:

If you are more than ten minutes late picking up your child(ren), you will be assessed a \$5/child late fee that will cover you for the entire hour until 1 pm. After 1 pm, \$5/child will be charged for each additional set of ten minutes.

Refund Policies:

- Cancellations received by 5 pm on June 1, 2012: half refund.
- No refunds for cancellations received after 5 pm on June 1, 2012 (unless for medical reasons accompanied by doctor's note).

Directions to Dumbarton House

Drop off will take place in the Museum's Bellevue Room. Park in the 27th Street lot behind the house and follow signs.

Dumbarton House is accessible by Metro. Take the Red Line to the Dupont Circle Station, Q Street North exit. The Museum is approximately six blocks west on Q Street, just over the Q Street Bridge into Georgetown – a short walk, or bus ride on the D-2 or D-6 bus lines.

DRIVING TO DUMBARTON HOUSE...

FROM THE NORTH: Down Wisconsin Avenue, turn left onto Q Street, drive 5.5 blocks to the Museum. Turn left on 27th street, into the gravel area, and left into the parking lot.

FROM THE SOUTH: Up Interstate 395, bear onto Washington Boulevard (Virginia Highway 27) to and across Arlington Memorial Bridge, bear left of the Lincoln Memorial, turn left onto 23rd Street, go around Washington Circle and onto Pennsylvania Avenue toward Georgetown, turn right onto 28th Street, turn right onto Q Street, go .5 blocks to the Museum. Turn left on 27th street, into the gravel area, and left into the parking lot.

FROM THE WEST: Toward D.C. on Interstate 66, exit at Roslyn, turn left on North Lynn Street, cross Francis Scott Key Memorial Bridge, turn right on M Street, turn left on 28th Street, turn right onto Q Street, go .5 blocks to the Museum. Turn left on 27th street, into the gravel area, and left into the parking lot.

Directions to Tudor Place

Drop off will take place at the Museum's Pierce Arrow Exhibit Hall. Park on 31st Street, enter the site through the main gates at 1644 31st and follow signs.

Tudor Place is a 20-minute walk from the Dupont Circle or Foggy Bottom Metrorail stops. From the Dupont Circle Metrorail Station, Tudor Place is located on the D-2 (Glover Park-Dupont Circle) or D-6 (Sibley Hospital-Stadium Armory) bus lines.

DRIVING TO TUDOR PLACE...

FROM THE NORTH: Down Wisconsin Avenue turn left onto Q Street. Go two blocks. Make a left onto 31st Street. The Museum Entrance will be located on your left.

FROM THE SOUTH: Cross Key Bridge (stay in the right lane) and turn right onto M Street and continue through three traffic lights, crossing Wisconsin Avenue. At the third light, turn left on 31st Street and continue for 6 blocks. The Museum Entrance will be located on your left.
